#### Schedule C

#### **Decision Matrix**

## A. Purpose

The matrix will be applied to resolve scheduling conflicts between SAIT schools and departments when the same room is requested at the same dates/times.

## B. Scope

- 1. Credit programs and courses and non-credit programs and courses, including apprenticeship will be required to follow the decision matrix when conflicts arise over the use of space.
- 2. Conflicts that cannot be resolved using the matrix will go to the Scheduling Appeals Committee. Refer to Schedule A.

### C. Process

- 1. Each program area that is seeking use of the space should complete the matrix.
- 2. The competing programs should meet and compare and discuss the matrix results.
  - a) If they are able to reach a decision, they will share the decision with the scheduling teams.
  - b) If they cannot reach a decision, they will submit a request for adjudication to Scheduling Appeals Committee. The request should include both completed matrices along with a rationale from each program area.
