# PERS 143: Queer Inclusion and Belonging at SAIT

PERS 143: Queer Inclusion and Belonging at SAIT is an introduction to equity, diversity and inclusion, with a focus on the 2SLGBTQ+ community. This free two-module course is open to SAIT students, staff and faculty.

The first module, Queer Essentials, is an online self-directed course designed to be completed in 60 minutes. The course includes terminology, history, unconscious bias and resources. SAIT students can register through <a href="maysalt">mysalt</a> while employees can access the course through <a href="PeopleNOW">PeopleNOW</a>.

The second module, Creating an Inclusive Environment, is a 90-minute face-to-face facilitated workshop. It applies the learnings from the first module which includes demonstrating how to use appropriate terminology, examining your pre-conceptions about the 2SLGBTQ+ community, recognizing your own biases, allyship in real life and developing your own strategies for creating an inclusive environment at SAIT.
